



Code of Conduct for Parents, Fans and Athletes

At St. Bartholomew Academy, we believe that sportsmanship is a core value and its promotion and practice are essential. This code of conduct applies to all parents, fans, and athletes involved in interscholastic athletics and activities.

1. Parents/Fans/Athletes will promote academic, emotional, physical and moral well-being above desires and pressure to win.
2. Parents/Fans/Athletes will teach, enforce, advocate, model and promote the development of good character to include:
 - a. Trustworthiness
 - b. Respect
 - c. Responsibility
 - d. Caring
 - e. Fairness
 - f. Citizenship
3. Parents/Fans/Athletes will respect participants, officials, opponents, coaches, and all others involved in a game or activity. Parents/Fans/Athletes will respect game officials and their authority during games. (Game officials include referees and score keepers.)
4. Parents/Fans/Athletes will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at or immediately following a game, but will take time to speak with coaches at a mutually agreed upon time and place.
5. Parents/Fans/Athletes will promote fair play and uphold the spirit of the rules of the game.
6. Parents/Fans/Athletes will model appropriate behavior at all times and will not engage in any un-sportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.
